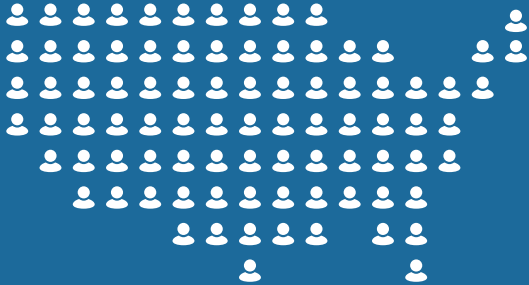


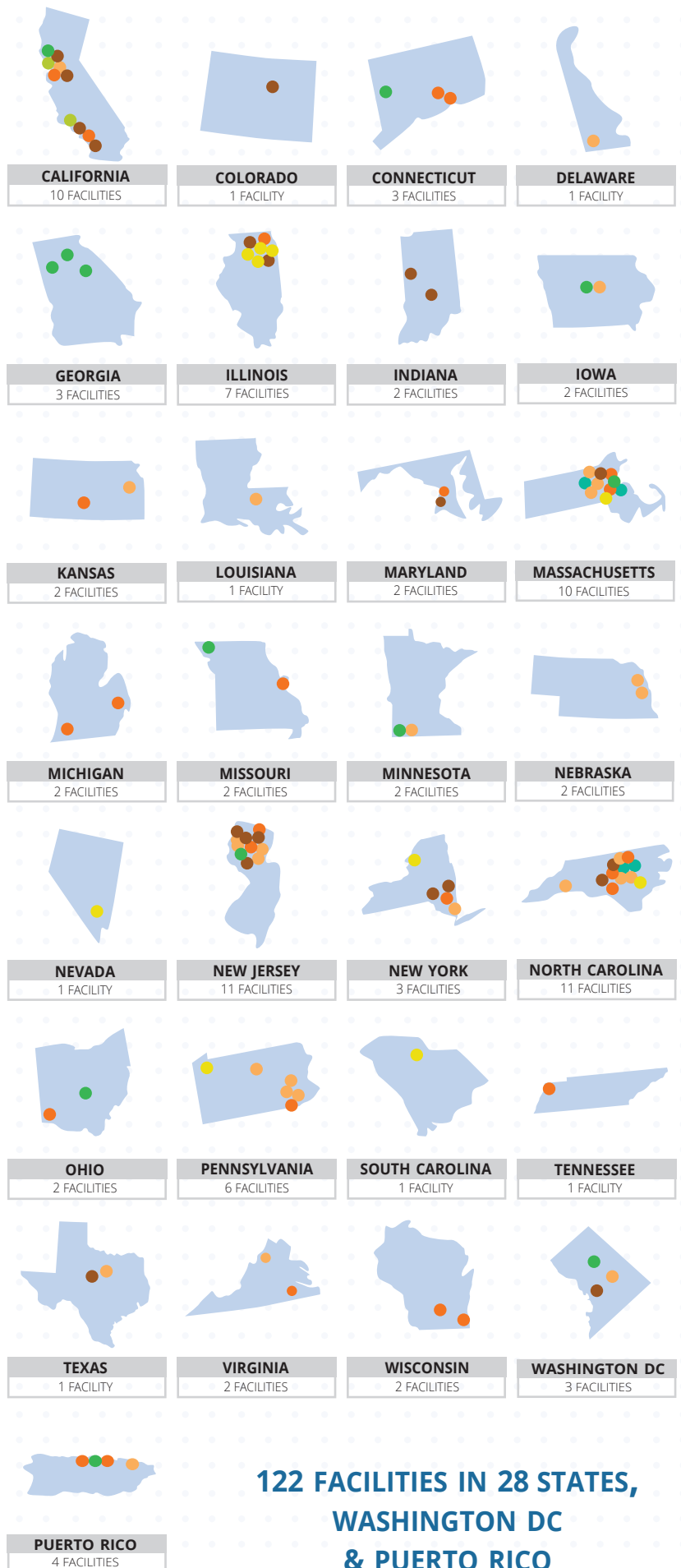
60,000+ AMERICANS ARE EMPLOYED BY BIOSIMILARS FORUM MEMBER COMPANIES
